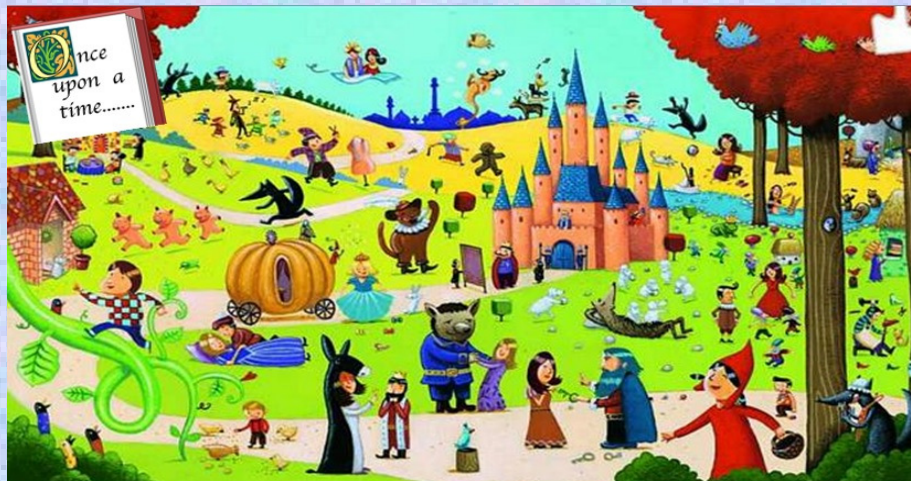
Team STW Hockey Tournament Y5/6
